Our Ongoing Impact



Independent climate research

In just over five years, the Climate Council has published over 100 reports, briefing papers and fact sheets. This work creates a resounding drumbeat of information in the community and the national political discourse, pushing the dial towards greater awareness and action.

From bushfires in NSW and Victoria to the supercharged storms that brought down transmission towers in SA, the Climate Council has been on the forefront of educating Australians on the impacts of extreme weather events exacerbated by climate change. The Climate Council has also published a range of landmark reports on climate

change solutions, including renewable energy and storage technology.

Our reports have informed government and agency policies, emergency services planning, educational resources and the basis of other campaigns organised by the environmental movement.



Keeping Australians informed on the energy debate

Australia's energy future has been at the centre of national debate with rising energy prices, the role of gas and 'clean coal' leading discussion. The Climate Council has been a key player with significant interventions in the media combating rampant misinformation.

We've released fact sheets on the myth of clean coal, produced a series of videos mythbusting fossil fuels and even had our CEO Amanda McKenzie appear on Q&A to discuss Australia's energy future. In the face of federal inaction, we developed a *Roadmap to a Renewable Future* outlining the policy framework required for Australia to cut emissions, while ensuring energy is reliable and affordable.



Cities Power Partnership

The Cities Power Partnership is Australia's largest climate program for local government. It currently represents over 100 local councils and almost 11 million Australians.

The Cities Power Partnerships supports local councils to become leaders in ramping up clean energy solutions projects. The program seeks to create a network of councils sharing knowledge through briefings, roundtable discussions, community events and online webinars.

Climate solutions projects have included Lismore's floating solar farm, the ACT's revolutionary electric vehicle ramp up and Strathbogie's fantastic bulk buy that helps pensioners save money by using cost-effective solar.



Our Community

With every report, email, video and headline we are upskilling and educating our supporters to tackle climate change. Our community share our research with their friends, families and networks and ensure solutions to climate change are on our nation's agenda.

It is our community who sign petitions, call their MPs and write letters to their local newspaper, demanding a strong commitment to a climate and energy solution. Our incredible supporters fundraise for the Climate Council through educational trips to the Kimberley and Lord Howe Island, getting involved in the City2Surf and even hosting a lemonade stand in their neighbourhood.

How do I leave a gift in my will?



Talk with your family

Take the time to talk with your family and loved ones about why you have chosen to leave a gift to the Climate Council.



Choose the type of gift you would like to give

There are many types of bequests you can choose to leave depending on your personal preference.

- Specific Bequest - Provide a certain sum of money or property you would like to gift
- Percentage Bequest- specifies the share you would like each beneficiary to receive
- Residual Bequest - Provide for your family and loved ones first and leave what remains as a gift
